

CASALI SCHOOL OF DANCE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR A SAFE OPENING FOR THE 2020-2021 SEASON

It is our responsibility and our mission to help reduce health risks to our dancers and staff when we reopen. Safety and cleanliness have always been a top priority at Casali School of Dance and this will continue to be emphasized in our new season. We will continue to review guidelines set forth by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, as well as the Center for Disease Control and Prevention.

- 1. A waiver must be signed before attending any class.
- 2. Dancers will enter the building through the studio door marked Enter Only. Dancers will exit the building through the door marked Exit Only.
- 3. Please wait outside until someone from the staff greets you. Please maintain 6' social distancing.
- 4. Covid-19 symptoms will be displayed on the door. Review and do not enter if you or your child have any of the symptoms. If you are not able to participate in person a Zoom option will be available. Please notify the studio 30 minutes prior to your child's class if they are participating in Zoom that day. If your child or anyone in your household is ill, please do not bring your child to class.
- 5. Please notify the studio if you or your child has an underlying health conditions. Please take extra precautions recommended by your physician.
- 6. Studio lobby will be closed to all parents and siblings. We ask parents of dancers 7 and under to bring them into the building and then remain in the parking lot for the duration of the class. In the event your child needs assistance using the restroom, make sure the office has your cell phone number so we can contact you in case you are needed.
- 7. Please be on time for start and pickup.
- 8. MASKS must be worn at all times and must cover both the nose and mouth. Dancers should also have an extra mask in their bag. The studio will have disposable masks available in case of an emergency.
- 9. Some classes have been shortened this year to allow extra time needed for entering, exiting and sanitizing. For the next few months, observation of the last 5 minutes of class will be moved to the outside windows of the studio along 9-Mack Drive. Dancers will be dismissed by the exit only door by a staff member. We ask the parents to meet their dancer at the exit door, unless you notify the studio that your child may walk to their car alone.
- 10. Anyone entering the building will have their temperature taken and be asked health questions. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5 F or higher will not be allowed to enter.

- 11. Your dancer will receive a sanitized basket where they will place their shoes, coat, dance bag and water bottles. They will then be directed to their 6' x 6' marked dance square. Upon dismissal the teacher will collect baskets and they will be disinfected to be used at a later time.
- 12. Barres, mats, and any other equipment at this time Dancers will use hand sanitizer upon arrival and when necessary during their class
- 13. In the event your dancer has a break between classes, they will need to remain in their 6' x 6' square.
- 14. The Staff will sanitize each room before a new group dancers enter. The bathrooms will also be sanitized throughout the evening. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the studio.
- 15. Weather permitting, we will have the doors open to help circulate proper air flow.
- 16. We will be using the BAND app and FB for daily communication. Make sure you are set up to receive notifications. We encourage the dancers to use the BAND app as well. Invites to Band will be emailed. Please friend us on FB at Casali Dance so we can place you in our private parent group.
- 17. A payment drop- off box will be in lobby. Please place your tuition in an envelope with your child's name on it. If paying by cash, a receipt will be sent home the following week.
- 18. No items including dance bags maybe left at the studio overnight.

Reminders

- All parents should do a self-check with their dancer of COVID-19 symptoms prior to dance class.
- If you are or your student are ill, or living with anyone who is ill, please stay home (Zoom will be available)
- Maintain social distancing at all times and in all spaces at the studio. Avoid physical contact, including hugs, high-fives and fist bumps.

- MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES INSIDE THE BUILDING!
