Important Recital Guidelines

- -Taking pictures or video is prohibited. A professional video will be available for purchase. Order forms are available at the studio, Rehearsal, and Recital.
- -No jewelry (unless provided by the Studio as a costume accessory). If a Band-Aid is worn, it must be beige.
- -No tattoos
- -No nail polish
- -No tan lines (Use make-up to cover)
- -All Dancers under 13 must have an adult present at recital either working backstage or in the audience.
- -We request that parents working backstage do not bring siblings.
- -Use cover-ups, no dance shoes outside, bring sneakers to walk around the hallways.
- -Dancers should come in costume for their first dance of the show. Show orders are available at the studio or on the website (www.casalidance.com).
- Enter the auditorium from the front door where there will be a "Dancers Entrance" sign. Dancers and working parents will check in at the check-in table. Dancers will be assigned a classroom where they will stay during the recital. Working parents will be given a wristband and their location to work backstage. Parents not working backstage may escort their child to their assigned room, get them settled, and then proceed to the auditorium for the show. Only those parents signed up to work will be allowed backstage. For the safety of the children, doors to the outside are locked during the performance and Intermission. No one is allowed backstage during the show without a wristband. **All working parents and dancers must remain backstage for the duration of the recital.**
- -Backstage doors are locked at 6:30pm. All dancers should be there by 6:00. If you are getting your hair done, the Hair Dressers will be there at 5:00. (Cost \$7) Please check the recital order to plan enough time for getting your hair done.
- -We are on school grounds. Tobacco and Alcohol are PROHIBITED.
- Please see the Casali website for YouTube video links regarding Recital policies and procedures, makeup application, and techniques for doing hair in a Recital bun.
- -For your convenience, Scarlet Poppy will be selling flowers in the lobby of the auditorium for both Recitals.

Dance Combo parents ONLY: If you signed up to pick up your child at intermission, please be patient and our backstage staff will assist you in retrieving your child.

Dance Combo, Jazzy Hoppers, and Tap/Jazz and Ballet Classes

What to bring backstage to Recital:

- ***Please label everything with your child's name: makeup, dance shoes, snacks, dance bag, etc... Try to pack all your child's belongings in one bag***
- -Makeup in a ziplock or makeup bag because it may need to be reapplied backstage.
- -Water bottle. No pop or colored drinks allowed.
- -Snacks: Please do not bring peanut or nut products, chocolate or messy snacks like Cheetos/Doritos that will stain costumes. Some suggestions are pretzels, goldfish, or fruit snacks.
- -Cover up or sweater
- -Blanket to sit on
- -If their dance is tap, bring another pair of soft soled shoes for them to wear backstage.
- -Activities, crafts, games, etc... to keep the children occupied while they wait before and after their dance.

Hair Time: The Hairdresser will be available at 5:00pm. If you are getting your child's hair done by the hair dressers backstage, please follow the following time guidelines for dances that are earlier in the Recital.

5:45: Oogie Woogie Boogie, Rainbow Connection, Make Some Noise (Dancers must be ready to line up at 6:30.)

6:00: I'd Like to Teach the World to Sing, You Are My Sunshine, Be Our Guest, Crazy Little Thing Called Love

6:30: Happy Day, BFF Song, Thrift Shop, Hair Up

The Combo classes and Jazzy Hoppers (except for dancers that have Ballet or Tap/Jazz dances as well) will be dismissed by class from the stage at the conclusion of the Recital.

Parents working backstage will be directed into the wings to pick up their child. If you are watching the Recital, we will ask one parent to come down to the stage to get your child when their class is being dismissed. We are very careful and attentive to safety with the children. Please do not send someone to get your child that we do not know. If someone unfamiliar to us will be picking up your child, you must alert Miss Anna, Miss Patti or Mrs. Casali before the recital.
